




























































































































































Panorama of Jezreel Valley from Megiddo








































According to the holy scriptures, who is God?

"Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth; For I am God, and there is no other. I have sworn by Myself, the word has gone forth from My mouth in righteousness and will not turn back, that to Me every knee will bow, every tongue will swear allegiance" (NASB; Is. 45:22-23). We all believe with the heart, and confess with the mouth, that there is only one living and true God. And we detest the multitude of gods, because it is expressly written, "The LORD our God is one LORD" (KJV; Deut. 6:4), and, "There is no other God besides Me" (NASB; Is. 45:21).
