A. I should wish to learn it, that, through a divine blessing, I may gain some acquaintance with those things which are of greatest importance.








What is the chief end of man?

For from Him **[as their origin]** and through Him [as their effectual means] and to Him **[as their ultimate end]** are all things. <u>To Him be the glory forever</u>. Amen (NASB; Rom. 11:36).

Whether therefore ye eat or drink, or whatsoever ye do, <u>do all to</u> the glory of God (KJV; I Cor. 10:31).

Whom have I in heaven but You? And besides You, I desire nothing on earth. My flesh and my heart fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever (NASB; Ps. 73:25-26).



What must I do in order to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever?

... know the God of your father, and serve [or, worship] Him with a whole heart and a willing mind ... (NASB; I Chron. 28:9).

In all your ways acknowledge [know] Him . . . (NASB; Prov. 3:6).

... the true worshipers will worship the Father in <u>spirit</u> [my innermost being] and <u>truth</u> [His revealed will]; for such people the Father seeks to worship Him (NASB; John 4:23).

In order to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever, I must know and worship Him in spirit and in truth.



How can I know about God?

By His creation: The heavens are telling the glory of God; and their expanse is declaring the works of His hands. Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night reveals knowledge (NASB; Ps. 19:1-2).

By His preservation: The eyes of all look to You, and You give them their food in due time. You open Your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing (NASB; Ps. 145:15-16).

By His government: Who is wise? Let him give heed to these things [**see Psalm 107:1-42**], and consider the lovingkindnesses of the LORD (NASB; Ps. 107:43).

I can know about God by His creation, preservation, and government of the universe; which are before my eyes as a most elegant book, wherein all creatures, great and small, are as so many characters leading us to contemplate "the invisible things of God." (Belgic Confession, Article 2, quoting Rom. 1:20)



How can I know about God most completely?

How blessed are those who <u>observe His testimonies</u>, who <u>seek Him</u> with all their heart (NASB; Ps. 119:2). **[Observing His testimonies is to seek and find Him.]**

<u>Search the scriptures</u> . . . they are they which testify of me (KJV; John 5:39).

I can know about God most completely by the holy scriptures.






