- 3 That everything we do falls short of being entirely righteous.

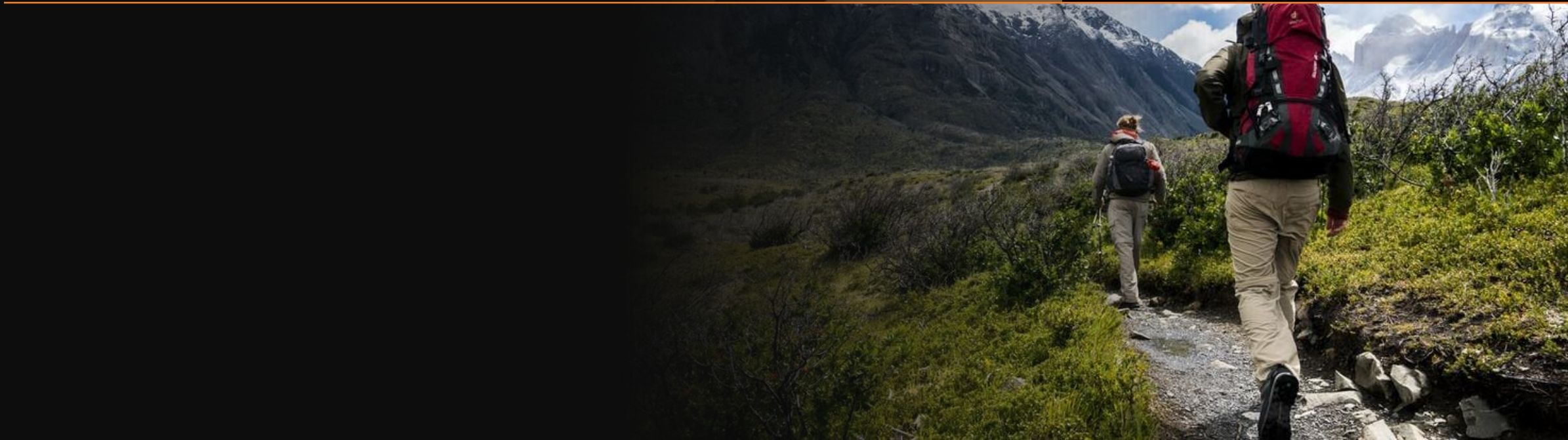
