Truly I say to you, not one stone here will be left upon another, which will not be torn down."</p> <p>³ As He was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying,</p> <p>"Tell us, when will these things happen,</p> <p>and what <i>will be</i> the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"</p> <p>⁴ And Jesus answered and said to them, "See to it that no one misleads you.</p> <p>⁵ "For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will mislead many.</p> <p>⁶ "You will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not frightened, for <i>those things</i> must take place, but <i>that</i> is not yet the end.</p>	<p>¹ As He was going out of the temple, one of His disciples said to Him, "Teacher, behold what wonderful stones and what wonderful buildings!"</p> <p>² And Jesus said to him, "Do you see these great buildings? Not one stone will be left upon another which will not be torn down."</p> <p>³ As He was sitting on the Mount of Olives opposite the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew were questioning Him privately,</p> <p>⁴ "Tell us, when will these things be,</p> <p>and what <i>will be</i> the sign when all these things are going to be fulfilled?"</p> <p>⁵ And Jesus began to say to them, "See to it that no one misleads you.</p> <p>⁶ "Many will come in My name, saying, 'I am <i>He</i>!' and will mislead many.</p> <p>⁷ "When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be frightened; <i>those things</i> must take place; but <i>that</i> is not yet the end.</p>	<p>⁵ And while some were talking about the temple, that it was adorned with beautiful stones and votive gifts,</p> <p>He said, ⁶ "As <i>for</i> these things which you are looking at, the days will come in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down."</p> <p>⁷ They questioned Him, saying,</p> <p>"Teacher, when therefore will these things happen?</p> <p>And what <i>will be</i> the sign when these things are about to take place?"</p> <p>⁸ And He said, "See to it that you are not misled; for many will come in My name, saying, 'I am <i>He</i>,' and, 'The time is near.</p> <p>' Do not go after them.</p> <p>⁹ "When you hear of wars and disturbances, do not be terrified; for these things must take place first, but the end <i>does not follow</i> immediately."</p>

<p>and you will be hated by all nations because of My name. . .</p> <p>¹⁰ "At that time many will ^{1a}fall away and will betray one another and hate one another. ¹¹ "Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many. ¹² "Because lawlessness is increased, most people's love will grow cold.</p> <p>¹³ "But the one who endures to the end, he will be saved.</p> <p>¹⁴ "This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations,</p> <p>and then the end will come.</p> <p>¹⁵ "Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand), ¹⁶ then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains.</p> <p><u>Critical Chronological Observation</u></p> <p>Let's look again at verse 9.</p> <p>⁹ "<u>Then</u> they will deliver you to tribulation. . .</p> <p>The "then" (tote) with which Matthew 24: 9 begins indicates that the next events <u>follow</u>. But look at Luke's chronological note.</p>	<p>¹³ "You will be hated by all because of My name,</p> <p>but the one who endures to the end, he will be saved.</p> <p>¹⁴ "But when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION standing where it should not be (let the reader understand),</p> <p>then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains.</p> <p>⁹ "But be on your guard; for they will deliver you to <i>the</i> courts. . .</p>	<p>¹⁷ and you will be hated by all because of My name. ¹⁸ "Yet not a hair of your head will perish.</p> <p>¹⁹ "By your endurance you will gain your lives.</p> <p>²⁰ "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then recognize that her desolation is near.</p> <p>²¹ "Then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains. . .</p> <p>¹² "But <u>before</u> all these things, they will lay their hands on you and will persecute you. . .</p>

<p>The next verses in Luke describe events which appear to be nearly identical to those that Matthew says <u>follow</u>. But Luke states that Jesus clarified that they will happen <u>before</u> (pro) what he, Matthew and Mark had just recorded (21:8-11; 24:4-8; 13:5-8).</p> <p>So a chronological harmonization will require taking into account both time references (Matthew's "to te" and Luke's "pro").</p>		<p>¹² "But <u>before</u> all these things, they will lay their hands on you and will persecute you, delivering you to the synagogues and prisons, bringing you before kings and governors for My name's sake.</p> <p>¹³ "It will lead to an opportunity for your testimony.</p> <p>¹⁴ "So make up your minds not to prepare beforehand to defend yourselves;</p> <p>¹⁵ for I will give you utterance and wisdom which none of your opponents will be able to resist or refute."</p> <p>¹⁶ "But you will be betrayed even by parents and brothers and relatives and friends, and they will put <i>some</i> of you to death,</p> <p>¹⁷ and you will be hated by all because of My name.</p> <p>¹⁸ "Yet not a hair of your head will perish.</p> <p>¹⁹ "By your endurance you will gain your lives.</p> <p>²⁰ "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then recognize that her desolation is near.</p> <p>²¹ "Then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains, and those who are in the midst of the city must leave, and those who are in the country must not enter ¹the city;</p> <p>²² because these are days of vengeance, so that all things which are written will be fulfilled.</p> <p>²³ "Woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days; for there will be great distress upon the land and wrath to this people;</p> <p>²⁴ and they will fall by the edge of the sword, and will be led captive into all the nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled under foot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.</p>
